Notice of Race 17.1

#### Current wording

The results from the Bic Techno 293 and Laser 4.7 classes at the Championship will be used by ISAF towards the qualification of an individual's NOC into the 2010 YOG. Only nations from ISAF Group L MNA's will be eligible for the YOG qualification. #### Additional wording

There is a maximum of two places available per Event for Oceania. In order to determine which Nations are offered quota places, a Nation Ranking will be established. The Nation Ranking will be determined from the final overall results for the relevant Events at the 2010 Australian Youth Championships and established by taking the top performing, age eligible crew of each Oceania country, and listing them in finishing order from first to last. In the first instance ISAF will offer a quota place to those Nations placed first and second for each Event on the Nation Ranking. This Championship only qualifies the Nation and does not automatically qualify the athlete. The ISAF Member National Authority, in conjunction with their National Olympic Committee is responsible for determining their final athlete selection.
